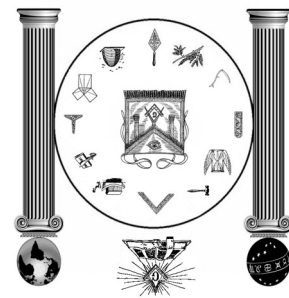

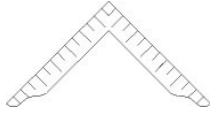

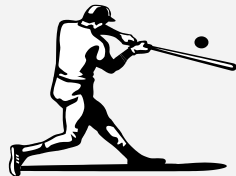

### “Anderson’s Constitutions of 1723”

“Modern” Masonry has deep roots in Masonic lore from the past that has been handed down through the centuries from one generation to the next. Our rituals, rules, and other ceremonies were not recently created but have both a historical path that can be traced and a spiritual path that goes back millenniums.

One document contains a set of rules that are still used in Masonry today. This document was written in 1723 by Dr. James Anderson and a Grand Lodge committee. Their manuscript, now often referred to as “Anderson’s Constitutions” was adopted from much older rules and laws that were handed down from the Middle Ages. These earlier records are referred to as the “Ancient Charges” and were extracted from “The Ancient Records of Lodges beyond the Sea...”

“The Charges of a Free Mason” included such guidance as topics on God, religion, obligations to your country, your Lodge, your Masters, Wardens, Fellows and Apprentices. It included guidance on the work ethic, behavior in and outside the Lodge, and behavior to strangers who were not Masons.
